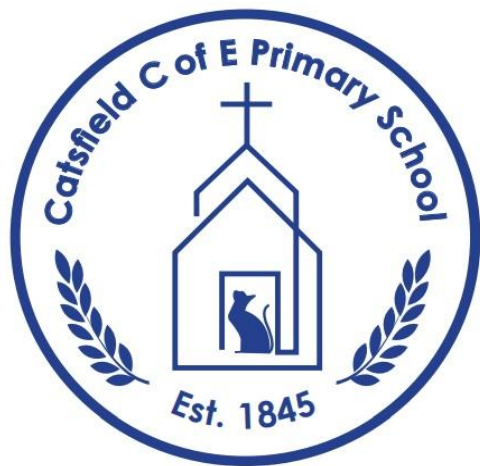

Dear Families,

As we come to the end of the year, we would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your continued support of our Wraparound Care provision. We are delighted with how the service has grown and developed, becoming an important part of school life for many of our families. This year alone, we have served over **2,000 breakfasts** and accommodated more than **550 ad hoc bookings!** We are incredibly proud of its success and grateful for the trust you place in us to provide a safe, welcoming and enjoyable environment for your children before and after the school day.



We are aware that some families will be aware of their requirements for wraparound care next academic year, so to support this we are opening the bookings for September before we finish for the summer holidays. Bookings are open from today.

Key dates:

Bookings close	Friday 4 th September 9am
Payment deadline to guarantee place	Monday 7 th September
Wraparound care starts	Monday 7 th September

For bookings received before the end of term invoices will be issued before the holidays.

We will continue to accept ad – hoc bookings throughout next academic year. Please just email the office with your requirements. Please note that we ask that these are paid for in advance of your child attending the session wherever possible.

The below details the choices available when booking your child's place. We have tried to incorporate a variety of activities to make the sessions as rewarding and appealing to the widest possible range of children. Play based activities run at every session and include arts and crafts, card and board games, kinetic sand, play doh, puzzles etc. On the PING form please indicate which activity your child would prefer. If we feel that your child may be better suited to an activity, for example the age range of children attending maybe a lot older than your child, we will contact you directly to discuss.

Time 2 Dance – Key Stage 2 only

We are going to be participating in the annual Time 2 Dance Festival in early February at the White Rock Theatre in Hastings. This is a fantastic opportunity for the children to get to perform a professionally choerographed routine on stage. We really hope that lots of children both girls and boys sign up for this amazing opportunity.

In previous years, the school has been able to fund the cost of these sessions through funding from the Government's PE and Sport Premium. The Department for Education has announced that schools will no longer be receiving this funding and therefore we are no longer able to fund the cost of Time 2 Dance in the way we have done previously. Instead this will be charged in line with other Wraparound Care activities at £4.50 a session.

To book your child onto this activity for terms 1-3 please complete the normal PING Wraparound Care Booking form. We understand that this represents a change for families and appreciate your understanding as we work to continue offering a range of enriching activities for our children despite ongoing funding pressures.



After school session 2 runs from 4.15 -5.15pm

At this session the children are offered a range of snacks. See the menu below for an indication of what is served. After refuelling a range of activities are available for your child which includes play activities, watching a film, playing outside. This is driven by how the children are feeling and their own personal interests.

Payment information - Each session will cost £4.50.

Once you have submitted your request via the PING form attached, an invoice will be sent to you via email. This can be paid in two ways:

- Go onto ParentPay and select the "Wraparound Care" payment item and enter the total amount on your invoice
- Pay via your online government Childcare account. We are a registered Wraparound Care provider and able to accept payments via this method.

The invoice will be pasted as an image in the email. If this does not appear you may need to ensure that you "Trust sender"

Support with funding Childcare

We urge everyone who uses the service to investigate the tax-free childcare options offered by the Government, as this can make a significant contribution to the cost of wraparound care. Tax-Free Childcare is a UK wide offer. Eligible working parents with children 11 or under can get up to £2,000 per child, per year, towards their childcare costs (or up to £4,000 for disabled children 16 or under).



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Tax-Free Childcare	Universal Credit Childcare
• For working families, including the self-employed, in the UK • Earning under £100k and at least £183 per week (equal to 16 hours at the National Minimum or Living Wage) each • Who aren't receiving Tax Credits, Universal Credit or childcare vouchers • With children aged 0-11 (or 0-16 if disabled) • For every £8 they pay into an online account, the government will add an extra £2, up to £2,000 per child per year (or up to £4,000 per child if disabled) Can be accessed through your registered providers and childminders who have activated their Tax-Free Childcare accounts.	• For working families claiming Universal Credit, in England, Scotland, and Wales. Northern Ireland has separate arrangements. Eligibility criteria apply • Both parents working – unless one of the allowable exceptions is met • With children usually under 17 (including disabled) • Up to 85% of eligible childcare costs can be reclaimed • Upfront support is available to fund your first month's payment. Ask your work coach for more information • Tax-Free Childcare is not available if also claiming Working Tax Credit, Child Tax Credit, Universal Credit or childcare vouchers Can be accessed through registered providers or childminders.

Parents using the scheme open an online childcare account which they use to pay the school directly for childcare. Payments work through an online bank account. Each payment is accompanied by a reference number for each child so you can identify their payments. Please see the documents attached to this PING which give further information on this scheme. If anyone requires any further advice or support with this process, please speak to Mrs Anderson who is happy to help.
